### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

#### **GROUND**

The site is a playing field within the village and is only used on a few occasions during the year as a temporary caravan site.

During the relevant season, the centre of the field is marked out and used as a football pitch, a Children's Play area, and a newly laid Ball Sports Area are situated in one corner.

#### **SITING YOUR CARAVAN**

Ralliers are requested to set up adjacent to Beck Lane and must be prepared to level their outfits, using their own levelling equipment.

As the football pitch is used on a Saturday and Sunday during the football season, you will be advised when there are matches and on these occasions you must place your caravans around the perimeter of the field. Please ensure that the caravans are arranged in straight lines.

#### **BOOKING / FEES**

Fees will in future be reviewed annually in the autumn for the following year commencing 1<sup>st</sup> January. Bookings can be taken in advance of this but the new charge will be applied from 1<sup>st</sup> January for that year, irrespective of when the booking is made.

#### **A FEE IS PAYABLE FOR THE USE OF THE VILLAGE HALL PER DAY OR PART OF A DAY**

#### **AN ADDITIONAL FEE IS PAYABLE FOR USE OF THE KITCHEN IN THE VILLAGE HALL**

A deposit of £50 will be required, on arrival, for the use of the village hall. This deposit will be refunded if no damage occurs.

Fees will be collected by a Village Hall Committee member during the course of the weekend.

Ralliers who do wish to make a future booking whilst on site will still be able to do so by contacting the Village Hall Bookings Secretary. Once the fees have been set for the relevant season the Village Hall Bookings Secretary will contact you, at which time you can confirm you're booking.

#### **CANCELLATION**

The Village Hall Committee reserve the right to cancel your confirmed booking at anytime, due to unforeseen circumstances beyond our control and refund all monies paid.

The Village Hall Committee will not be liable for any injury or death, loss of property, damage suffered by the hirer or any member of your party. Your belongings are also your responsibility and are left at your risk during your stay in Appleby.

## **ACCESS**

Due to the narrow lanes in the village, it is easier to enter the playing field by turning off Ermine Street onto Church lane, then second right onto Church Side and continuing round onto School Lane. The gated access to the field is then straight in front. (Those who have been before will be aware of this route) Please do not drive down Haytons Lane as this is too narrow for caravans.

The gate on the field will be unlocked on the morning of the booking.

Caravans enter the site at their own risk. No responsibility is accepted for loss or damage however caused.

## **FACILITIES**

### **Village Hall**

The village hall is situated adjacent to the playing field and consists of two rooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and ladies, gents and a disabled toilet.

The village hall will be unlocked and locked by a village hall committee member and must be vacated by midnight. Please leave the village hall clean and tidy as you will have found it.

**PLEASE BE AWARE THE VILLAGE HALL IS A NO SMOKING AREA**

### **Water**

A standpipe is available on the playing field. The water is suitable for drinking.

### **Play Areas**

The two play areas are NOT for the sole use of the either guests using the field or the children of the village. It is expected that both will be able to use the play areas at any time.

### **Noise**

Ralliers are asked to ensure that any noise produced, regardless of the time of day, is neither irritating nor offensive to other caravaners, or to those villagers who live within hearing distance of the field/village hall.

### **Dogs**

As the playing field is a recreational area, no dogs are allowed access whether accompanied by residents or visitors. WE THEREFORE REQUEST THAT CARAVANERS DO NOT BRING DOGS WITH THEM.

### **Smoking**

The village hall is a no smoking area

### **Rabbit Holes**

The local wildlife has a penchant for digging numerous holes/borrows across the playing field area.

Please bear this in mind when moving about the field on foot.

### **Accidents/Incidents**

All accidents/incidents must be reported TO THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE VILLAGE AHELL COMMITTEE AT THE EARLIETS SUITABLE TIME AND PRIOR TO LEAVING THE SITE.
